USES

Repairs cracks in concrete steps, driveways, sidewalks and also replaces missing mortar between bricks & cinderblocks.

LIMITATIONS

- Not recommended for marine, under water, or aquarium applications
- Not recommended for use on automobiles
- Not recommended for installation when rain is imminent (sealant may wash out before full cure)
- Not recommended for installation in sub-zero weather
- Apply only to clean, dry, frost-free surfaces

HOW TO USE

Surfaces to be sealed must be clean and dust free. Clean thoroughly to remove dirt, grease, wax, loose paint, dust, oil, loose grout, old caulk and mildew. Apply sealant with a standard caulking gun, using steady pressure to completely fill joints. For a neat appearance, smooth bead with a moistened finger, brush or cloth.

For best results, cured beads should be between 1/8" - 1/2" wide and 1/8" - 1/4" deep. A 1/8" x 1/4" bead will yield approximately 51 linear feet of sealant per cartridge. Use Backer Rod for cracks and seams deeper than 1/4".

Remove excess material before cure with a moistened cloth. Clean up tools with water. May be painted over with latex or oil based paints when dry (generally within 4 to 6 hours, depending on climatic conditions). Do not apply when rain is expected. Not intended for underwater use.

CAUTION

Not for internal consumption. Keep out of reach of children and pets. Keep from freezing.

Uncured sealant is irritating to the skin and eyes. Prolonged inhalation of vapors may cause irritation to the respiratory tract. Ensure adequate ventilation in work areas.

In case of eye contact, flush with large amounts of water; in case of skin contact, wash with soap and water. Get medical attention if any irritation persists. In the event of prolonged inhalation, move affected person to fresh air. If product is ingested give victim two glasses of water to drink and induce vomiting. Call physician immediately.

STORAGE AND SHELF LIFE

When stored in the original, unopened container at temperatures above 32°F (0°C), Innerbond C-600 Concrete & Mortar Filler has a shelf life of one year. After the container has been opened, a plug of cured material may form in the nozzle during storage. This may be easily removed and does not affect the remaining contents. Protect product from freezing.

PACKAGING

Innerbond C-600 Concrete & Mortar Filler is available in a 10.1 oz. Cartridge with a fixed nozzle for use in standard caulking guns.
